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### Eligibility

<b>Eligible Institutions</b>	<p>ANR may fund research organisations and undertakings, as defined by the EC regulation on State aid for research, development and innovation (see the ANR Funding regulations for further reference). Only research organisations that have their primary establishment in France may be funded. Within this framework:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>-public research</li><li>-institutions such as EPST, EPIC,</li><li>-Universities, University hospitals as well as foundations can apply, in general for up to 100% of so called “marginal” costs. This list is not comprehensive and funding rates vary.</li></ul> <p>Enterprises may also be eligible: Funding rates vary based on types of research and types of enterprises. For fundamental research, maximum rates of funding are: 45% of total costs for SMEs, 30% for larger companies.</p> <p>Please refer to ANR’s Funding regulations: <a href="https://anr.fr/en/funding-regulations/">https://anr.fr/en/funding-regulations/</a></p>
<b>Additional requirements</b>	Costs for clinical trials are not eligible for ANR

## Budget

<b>Total earmarked national budget</b>	<b>1 800 000</b>
<b>Anticipated no. of funded groups</b>	5-6
<b>Budget restrictions</b>	<p>The ANR has a maximum funding per partner for this call: each partner can request maximum <b>260 000 €</b>. The maximum amount is increased to <b>310 000 €</b> for a French partner in charge of the consortium coordination. Minimum amount per partner: 15 000 €.</p>
<b>Eligible costs</b>	<p>Eligible costs and rates of funding depend on the type of partners. Among others, eligible costs may include the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>•Personnel costs;</li><li>•Equipment costs;</li><li>•Consumables and animal costs;</li><li>•Travel and subsistence costs; sub-contracting costs.</li><li>•Overheads (14,5% of total requested costs for partners funded at “marginal” costs)</li></ul> <p>Subcontracting costs cannot exceed 50% of the total requested funding amount for a partner.</p> <p>Please refer to ANR’s Funding regulations <a href="https://anr.fr/en/funding-regulations/">https://anr.fr/en/funding-regulations/</a></p>
